Monsters Around The World

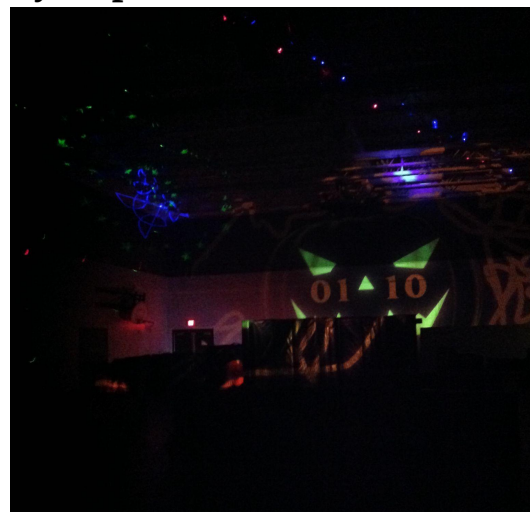

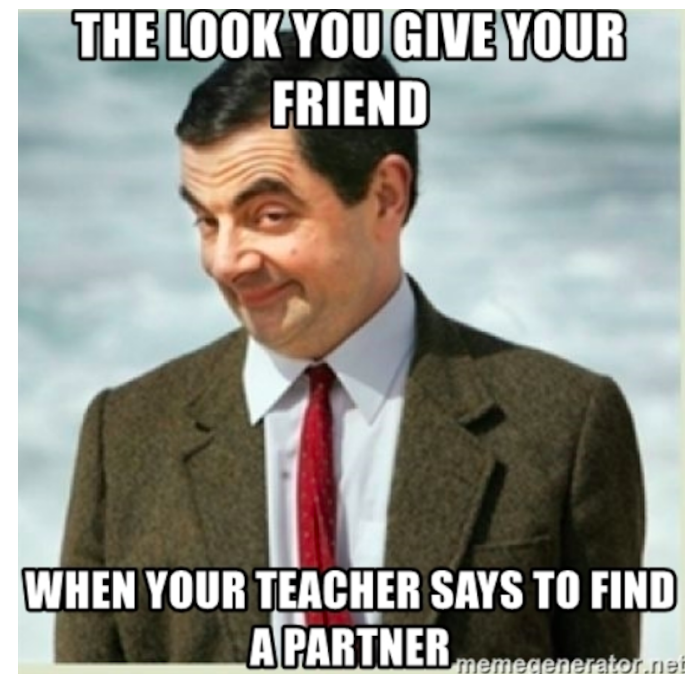

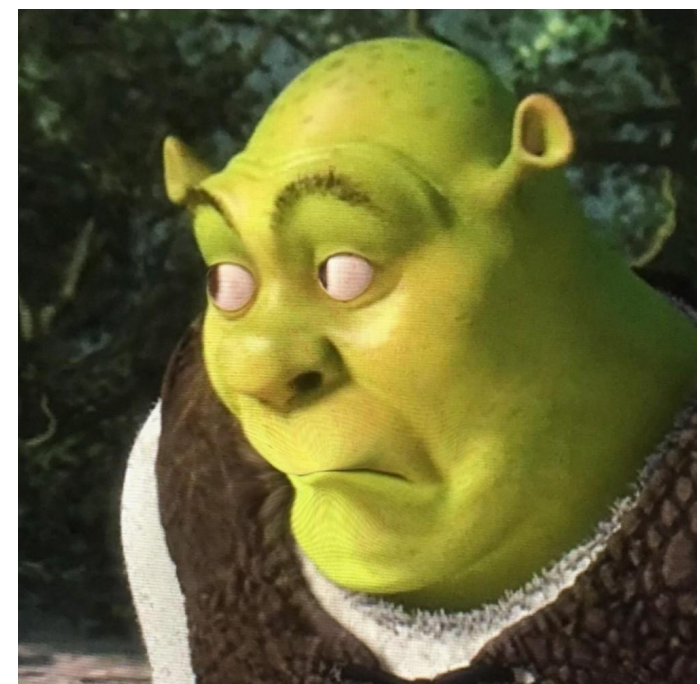
